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# 徐老师原典英语自学法 推荐

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## 内容及特色介绍

Password Readers 系列读物精选了原创和经典的小说类作品。这些作品经过改编后更加适合英语学习者的需要。该系列读物为读者自主学习提供了实用且易理解的学习材料。每册读物由十余个六页长度的章节组成，故事与练习交替循环，既巩固词汇学习，又增强阅读技巧。每个故事结束后还配有与主题相关的背景信息，有助于读者深入理解文本并扩大知识面。每册读物均配有一张音频光盘，在提高听力的同时，也给人一种听的享受。先听再读，你会发现每本书都具有更为丰富的价值。

### 第一级(Beginner)

这一级别读物几乎都以现在时陈述，出现一些情态动词，尤其是 must 和 can；并包含大量关于形容词、介词和疑问词的练习。在第一级的读物中，插图在词汇学习与测试中起到了重要的作用。

### 第二级(Elementary)

这一级别读物几乎都以现在时陈述。其中也出现一些情态动词的使用，尤其是 must, can, should, have to。这一级别的大多数读物包含关于形容词比较级、不规则名词复数形式，以及疑问词和疑问句的练习。每册读物都配有全彩色插图，既帮助读者加强对文章的理解，又增加练习题的生动性。

### 第三级(Pre-intermediate)

几乎所有故事都以现在时讲述，涉及少量过去时，尤其是 was 和 were。大多数读物都聚焦于常用的基本词汇，很少出现助动词，读者可以进一步学习形容词的比较级和疑问词的用法。

### 第四级(Intermediate)

一般过去时广泛地出现在这一级别的读物中。学生可以从中掌握不规则动词的过去时态变形。文章中还包括动词的一般将来时和一些常用情态动词的用法。这一级别的文章用词更为广泛，读者可以深入学习形容词比较级和最高级的用法。其中一些读本还讲述了更为复杂的语法结构，比如条件状语从句、不定式结构等。语法讲解采用大量疑问句和否定句作为例子，以加深对语法结构的学习。

### 第五级(Upper-intermediate)

这一级别读物涉及的话题及词汇主要聚焦于现代时尚行业：电视产品、时尚设计、电子银行等。这些故事的中心内容是商业事务及现代无线通信。文章中使用了中高级难度的动词时态和其他语法结构。

读者可根据自己实际的英语水平(如词汇量、语法知识、理解能力、阅读能力等)选择适合自己的读物，而不必受制于学校年级划分或学历高低的约束。关于本系列读物的其他信息，请参考书末最后一页。

**F**lorida is a very popular place with tourists. Many Americans go to Florida every year for their vacations and visitors from all over the world also come to Florida for its beautiful white sand beaches and endless sunshine.



The Florida Keys are a favourite holiday destination. They are a group of small islands south of Miami. They are about 120 miles long and cover an area of 137 square miles. They have a population of 80,955.

There are ten **main** islands and many more small islands. The islands are **connected** by a **chain** of bridges that together are forty miles long. The most famous bridge is the "Seven Mile Bridge". In the past there was a railway line that joined all of the keys together, but it was destroyed by a terrible hurricane in 1935. Now there is one main road that goes **through** the Florida Keys; it follows the same **route** as the old railway line and is called US1.



**E**ach of the islands is different and has its own special attractions. Tourists come to Key Largo for the spectacular **diving** and **snorkelling** it offers. Many people call it the "Dive Capital of the World". Islamorada is called "The Sportsfishing Capital of the World". There are fishing competitions there all year. Anyone can catch a fish when they visit Islamorada. And Key West is one of the largest keys and is a point of departure for visiting other islands in the Caribbean.

**W**hen the Spanish explorers first came to the Americas, they were looking for gold and other treasure. The Florida Keys area takes its name from the Spanish word *cayos*, which means "small islands". In 1763 the Spanish gave Florida to the British in exchange for the city of Havana in Cuba. Later, in 1821, all of Florida, including the islands, officially became part of the U.S.A.

## 背景知识

### 佛罗里达州在哪儿？

佛罗里达州是美国最美丽的州之一。它是美国东南部的一个半岛，位于墨西哥湾与大西洋之间。拥有 1300 万人口，其首府并不是大多数人所认为的迈阿密(Miami)，而是塔拉哈西(Tallahassee)。

佛罗里达州这个名字来源于西班牙语 *Pascua Florida*，其含义是“棕枝主日”(复活节前的星期日)。事实上，佛罗里达州是在 1513 年的棕枝主日被发现的。因这里的天气经常是晴朗炎热，佛罗里达州还有一个别名，叫做“阳光之州”。

佛罗里达州有许多有趣的野生动物。那里有鳄鱼和许多鸟类出没的沼泽，还有广阔的原始森林，里面有许多热带鸟类和其他动物栖息。佛罗里达州也因其美丽清澈的水资源而闻名。在海底有珊瑚礁，在那里你可以看到多姿多彩的鱼儿和奇妙的珊瑚。

许多人了解佛罗里达州是因为位于奥兰多(Orlando)的迪斯尼乐园。其实，这里还有很多吸引人的地方，例如大沼泽地国家公园(Everglades National Park)和环球电影公司(Universal Film Studios)。佛罗里达州最著名的地方之一就是位于卡纳维拉尔角(Cape Canaveral)的美国太空港(Spaceport USA)。美国第一个载人火箭就是从卡纳维拉尔角发射的。

### 佛罗里达礁岛群

——阳光，沙滩和潜水

佛罗里达州是一个深受旅游者喜欢的旅游胜地。每年，有很多美国人到佛罗里达度假，同时，也有许多来自世界各地的旅游者到那里享受美丽的白色沙滩和充足的阳光。

佛罗里达礁岛群是首选的度假目的地。在迈阿密南部有成群的小岛，小岛大约长 120 英里，占地 137 平方英里，拥有人口 80,955。那里有 10 座主要的岛屿，还有很多小岛。这些岛屿被长达 40 英里的一连串大桥相连。其中最著名的桥是七英里大桥(Seven Mile Bridge)。过去，有一条铁路线把所有礁岛连接起来，但是 1935 年一次可怕的飓风把桥摧毁了。现在，有一条连接佛罗里达礁岛群的公路，它与老铁路的路线相同，名叫 US1。

每一座岛屿各不相同，而且各有千秋。许多旅游者为奇·拉哥暗礁(Key Largo)蔚为壮观的跳水和潜水慕名而来，很多人将其称之为“世界的潜水之都”。伊斯拉莫拉达(Islamorada)被称为“世界钓鱼之都”，那里终年都举办钓鱼比赛，来伊斯拉莫拉达旅游的游客都可以钓鱼。基韦斯特(Key West)是最大的礁岛群之一，也是去加勒比海(Caribbean)其他岛屿旅游的出发点。

当西班牙的探险者第一次登陆美国，他们是为了寻找黄金和其他珍宝。佛罗里达礁岛群的名字来源于西班牙语“cayos”，意思是“小的岛屿群”。1763 年，西班牙人将佛罗里达让给英国，以交换古巴的哈瓦那(Havana)。后来，在 1821 年，包括这些岛屿在内的整个佛罗里达州正式成为了美国的一部分。

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
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
